**RESOLUTION:** ISO/IEC/JTC 1/SC 31/WG 4 requests SC31 to approve a one-year extension for ISO/IEC 18000-3 Amd 1 in order to have time to consider and accommodate the contribution from TC 122 and the expected contribution from EPCglobal. Immediately following the ballot, WG4/SG3 further requests that the WG4 Secretariat sends a resolution to the SC31 Secretariat for voting and subsequently to JTC1 for their approval.

**NOTES:** No negative votes or abstentions have been received. One comment has been received from Sweden:

SC 31/WG 4 N1151 (Postal member ballot for resolution for a one-year extension for ISO/IEC 18000-3 Amd 1) - Yes, with the condition that participating organizations not are allowed to change their position during ongoing work, which can result in changed conditions for the standardization work. Consensus ought to be valid for driving the work forward, i.e. one organization should not be allowed to have "VETO rights" which in principle stops the ongoing work. Why this short timeframe for voting?
