Current Work

- 18000-2 Second edition
 - Published



Current Work

- 18000-3 Third edition
 - FCD ballot closed 29 July 2009
 - BRM resolved most comments, created an adhoc to resolve remainder
 - Received a letter from Alien refusing to declare IP, meant that we have to design out any IP we believe they hold
 - Final FCD BRM call will be on 9 November 2009 to approve changes and send for 2nd FCD ballot



Current Work

- 18000-6 Second edition - 2nd FCD Ballot
 - FCD BRM finalized in September.
 - Project editors modified the standard and it was sent out for a 3rd FCD ballot with a request that comments should only be editorial unless a major error is found.
 - 3rd FCD ballot closes 04 January 2010



Current Work

- 18000-6 Problems

- As previously reported, the 18000-6 standard has grown to over 500 pages with many annexes
- An adhoc was established to look at this problem and it made recommendations as to how it could be solved. We learned at the end of October that the ISO advise was incorrect and you cannot have parts of parts. More work needs to be done.
